
Jobs after BBA Honours (General)

Degree Courses after BBA

- **PGDM**: Post Graduation Diploma in Management is a good alternative to MBA as it has a little more updated syllabus. PGDM Admission is done on the basis of entrance exams as well as on a merit basis. Both MBA and PGDM is a 2-year courses.
- **MMS:** Master of Management Studies or MMS is a 2-year postgraduate course which provides advanced general management knowledge. The course has been designed to offer managerial and leadership skills to the students.

Job Options after BBA

Students who wish to pursue BBA Honours (General) course should fulfil the following eligibility criteria in order to get through colleges offering BBA Honours (General) courses,

- Students should clear class 12th board exams.
- They should clear their class 12th board exams from a recognized board
