INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARTICIPANTS AND TEAM MANAGERS

1. Registration requirements are given in Srujanotsav Brochure. Please read carefully the conditions prescribed therein before registration.
2. All events will be conducted as per the schedule and the participants are required to be present at the timings as indicated. The sequence of participation will be decided by lots at the commencement of each event. If any participant/ team fails to report to the event desk at the scheduled time or when called for presentation on the stage, the Organising Committee shall exercise the discretion and reduce the time permitted to that event by 5 minutes and permit presentation either towards the end of that event or reject the presentation completely as deemed fit. The decision of the Organising Committee is final.
3. All the participants and team managers must wear the identity cards issued by the Srujanotsav Committee during their stay on the campus.
4. No participant/team incharge shall do anything in word/symbol/gesture or in any other manner indicating his/her name or the institution he/she represents during the course of competitions. In such eventuality, he/she stands automatically disqualified from that event.
5. All the Team Incharges/Team members and Individual participants are expected to comply with all the conditions prescribed for each event and cooperate with the Organising Committee. Any breach of discipline/procedure/violation will be viewed seriously and the Organising Committee is empowered to take disciplinary action as deemed fit and proper in the circumstances.
6. All the participants are advised to take care of their personal belongings. Organisers are not responsible for any loss.
7. Participants are not allowed to wear their College Uniform at the time of the competitions.
8. Each and every participant/Team Leader is responsible for the safety of the food coupons. Entry into the Dining Hall is restricted to coupon holders only.
9. All the participants may please collect their participation certificates between **12.00 NOON** and **2.00 P.M.** on **10.12.2011**(Day 2) from the Registration Desk in the Foyer or at any time as announced.
