

2.3.2 The institution adopts effective Mentor-Mentee Schemes to address academics and student psychological issues

The Parvathaneni Bramhayya Siddhartha College of Arts and Science has established a rigorous mentor-mentee system. Students are paired with more experienced persons, who are referred to as mentors, in order to offer them with direction, support, and inspiration. Mentoring is a structure that brings together students and teachers. Every single academic mentor is assigned a group of mentees that consists of around 20-30 students. Because it encourages students to grow in all aspects of their being, this has shown to be beneficial to the institution. Additionally, it encourages the formation of responsible citizens who demonstrate admirable conduct and responsibility in their academic endeavours as well as in their dealings with other people. A shared WhatsApp group will be established between the mentor and the mentees that they have allocated to them, with the faculty member serving as the only administrator of the group. Notifications of critical importance, including but not limited to insufficient attendance, instances of indiscipline, parent-teacher conferences, and test failures, will be sent within the group. It is necessary for the mentee to make arrangements for their parents to communicate with the mentor at the parent-teacher conference before addressing the Principal. In the course of the meeting between the teaching staff and the parents, the mentor will, in the presence of the Principal, provide the parents with information on the academic and behavioural characteristics of the specific mentee. A registration is maintained to record information about the mentee, and the signature of the parent will be collected from inside the registry. Through the use of the Mentor-Mentee method, the organisation has been able to accomplish a great deal of success, some of which are detailed below.

- Mentors with industry knowledge gave professional guidance, aided in CV enhancement, and offered insights into potential career paths.
- Mentors provide targeted instruction on study techniques, time management, and resolving academic challenges.
- The mentors acted as a platform for the individual's personal concerns and offered direction via their ongoing relationship.
- Mentoring has fostered a delicate sense of connection and belonging among students inside the institution, resulting in enhanced student engagement.

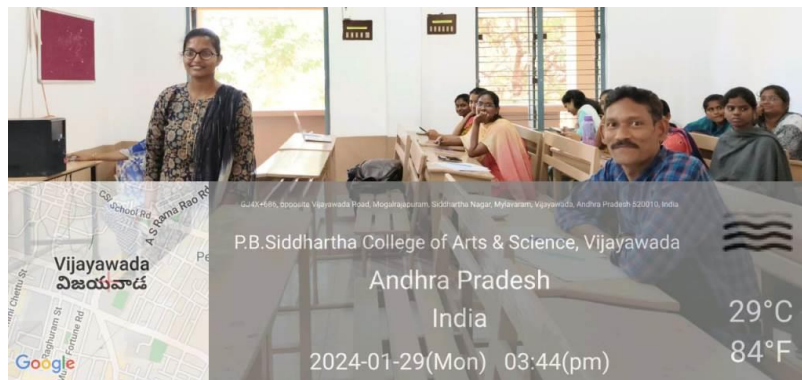

Awareness Session on "Computer Literacy and Security"

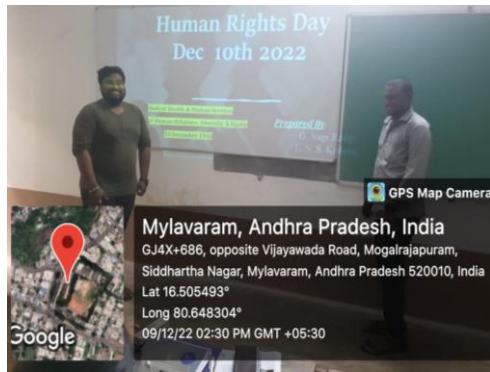
